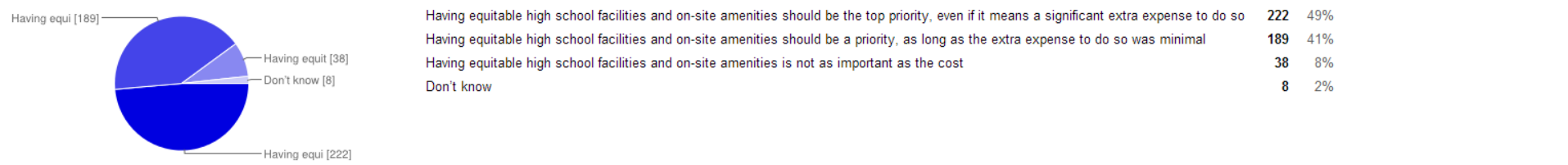
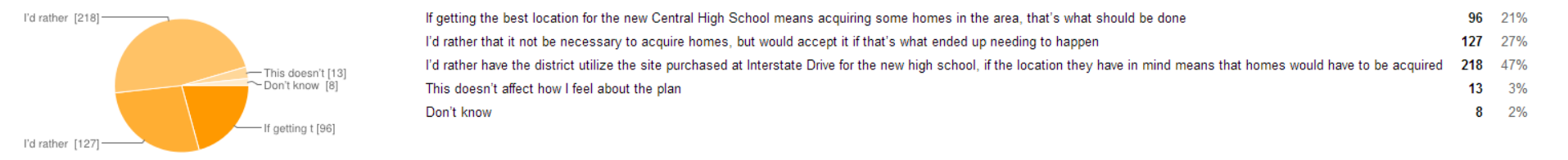

There are a lot of factors involved in the plans being considered at the high school level. Please consider the following options.

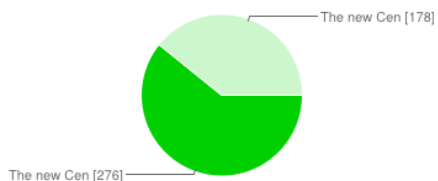

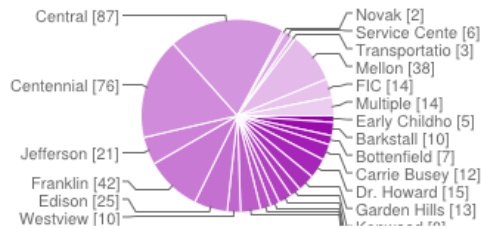


Thinking about all the options, which one is your preference? Is it...



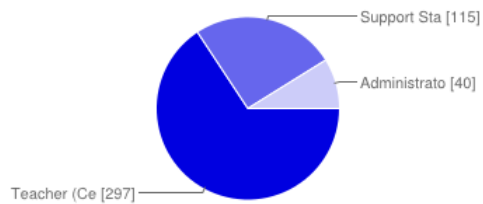
The new Central High School at Interstate Drive and Neil Streets, plus the renovation and additions to Centennial High	276	61%
